

Since 1984, **CFA Society of Los Angeles**, Inc. (CFALA), in partnership with the **University of Southern California**, Marshall School of Business (USC) has offered Chartered Financial Analysts® CFA® Review Programs for each level of the CFA Study and Examination Program. For Spring 2011, we are offering CFA Societies the opportunity to offer streaming media recordings of our Level I, II and III review program. Recordings are from our "live" spring 2011 classes. All class recordings will be available within 48 hours of each class recording.

If your candidates have high speed internet access, the USC/CFALA CFA Review Streaming Media Program can provide your society with a complete preparation course. Societies may choose to offer access to the recordings in a classroom environment or provide access to individual candidates.

The USC/CFALA CFA Review Program features state-of-the-art streaming media recordings of structured classroom-based instruction by practitioners in the financial industry and academics from local Universities. Instruction is focused on the comprehension of the assigned materials in the Study Guides with an emphasis on the **Learning Outcome Statements**. The program includes secure access to streaming media recordings of all study sessions and email communication with our instructors and coordinators.

Level I recordings offer over 60 hours of instruction with bonus classes in study/test taking tips, Accounting Essentials, a Quantitative Methods Review and a Financial Statement Analysis Review. Level II offers over 50 hours of instruction and Level III offers over 34 hours. All candidates will have email access to our instructors or coordinators to answer any questions. PDFs of each instructor's PowerPoint presentation and handouts are included.

Cost

The program cost per candidate is \$200. However, we offer societies a commission/rebate of 40% of the fee on the first 10 and 50% thereafter for streaming media registrants.
